Assistant to the lighting director in set and tear down of technical and lighting instruments.

# Teaching Artist Residency with North Coast Indian Council, Crescent City, CA; June 2019

During this two-week residency with two other collaborators, planned and taught physical theatre classes to a group Native American youth, ranging from 8 to eighteen. Met for four hours a day to develop content and confidence with them to devise an original play that examined the traditional uses and commercial abuse of tobacco. Worked as teaching artist, ensemble devisor, scriptwriter, and assistant director. This project was documented and filmed as part of a larger initiative to promote tobacco education and awareness.
